What is the State of CAre campaign?

State of CAre is a health care provider engagement campaign to expand the reach and impact of the ACEs Aware initiative. The campaign uses digital and print media to raise awareness about Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and the long-term health effects they can have on children and adults if not addressed.

The ask:

The core component of the *State of CAre* campaign is to drive all eligible clinicians and clinical teams to a free, two-hour "Becoming ACEs Aware in California" online training and certification that teaches providers to screen patients for ACEs and respond to the symptoms of toxic stress. We need your help informing providers across California about this free training and enhancing the public's understanding of the benefits of addressing toxic stress.


